1 pair of Knee Pads | 1 pair of Elbow Pads | 1 pair of Wrist Guards | This manual

Other enclosed parts are for transport protection and are not required for the assembly and use of the item.

3. Safety instructions

- These protectors are classified as Level 1 protective gear. They are designed to protect against minor risks such as superficial abrasions, light impacts, and vibrations that do not affect vital organs or cause any irreversible damage.
- Please remember that any rolling sport should be practiced with caution, and even the best protective equipment cannot guarantee complete safety.
- It is strongly recommended to use the full set of knee, elbow, and palm protectors, along with a well-fitting helmet.
- For use with skateboards, scooters, roller skates, and inline skates only.
- These protectors are not suitable for acrobatic roller sports.



- Any change in environmental conditions, such as temperature, may significantly impair the performance of the protector.
- Any contamination, modification, or misuse may dangerously reduce the performance of the protector.
- Recommended for use with roller skates, skateboards, and scooters for leisure activities.

Protective gear is categorized as follows:

Level 1: Leisure use

Level 2: Acrobatics

The protective gear included in this package belongs to **Level 1** of this classification.

4. Instructions for use

4.1. HOW TO ADJUST YOUR PROTECTIVE GEAR CORRECTLY

To maximize the protective effect, your gear must be properly adjusted to your body and should not slip.

At the same time, it must not be fastened too tightly, as this may restrict blood circulation.

4.2. HOW TO CHOOSE YOUR PROTECTIVE GEAR CORRECTLY

According to Performance Levels

- Level 1

Suitable for standard roller sports.

- Level 2

Designed for use in acrobatic roller sports.

According to Sizes

Choose the correct size of protector and ensure a proper fit.

Refer to the following guidelines based on age and body mass:

Size XS: 3–7 years (recommended age: 3+)

Size S: 6–10 years (recommended age: 5+)

Size M: 9–15 years (recommended age: 8+)

Size L: 12+ years

Weight-based sizing:

Size S (Range A): For users up to 25 kg

Size M (Range B): For users between 25 kg and 50 kg

Please check the sewing labels of the protectors to find LEFT and RIGHT indicators.

These protectors are certified for Level 1, available in Sizes S and M.

4.3. USE OF KNEE AND ELBOW PROTECTORS

1. Open the Hook and Loop straps.
2. Place the protector on your elbow or knee.
3. Wrap the closure strap around the joint and fasten the Velcro on the front.
4. Ensure both knee and elbow protectors are securely fastened to prevent slippage and provide maximum protection.

4.4. USE OF PALM PROTECTORS

1. Open the Hook and Loop straps.
2. Insert the thumb of your left hand through the hole so that the curved plastic piece faces your palm.
3. Wrap the longest Velcro strap around your palm and fasten it at the center of the protector.
4. Secure the upper and lower Velcro straps around your wrist and fasten them.

5. The curved plastic piece should face your palm.
6. Repeat the process for the right hand.
7. Double-check that both palm guards are firmly fastened to prevent slippage.

5. Care Instructions

- After each fall or use, inspect each protective item thoroughly.
- If you notice cracks or damage to the hard cups or the curved palm piece, replace the item immediately.
- To maintain Velcro effectiveness, handle it with care. If the Velcro loses its grip, it must be replaced.
- Do not replace any components of the protective gear, as this may compromise its effectiveness.
- Clean the gear by hand-washing only, using water and mild soap.
- Do not use strong detergents, chlorine, ammonia, fuel, or solvents.
- Avoid exposure to environmental conditions (e.g., extreme heat or cold) that could reduce performance.
- No protector can guarantee complete protection from injury.
- Any contamination, damage, or misuse can seriously affect performance.
- Follow recommendations for inspections, repair limitations, and when to discard gear that may no longer provide adequate protection.



6. Storage

Store your protective gear in a clean, dry place at temperatures between 5°C and 30°C.

Use a protective bag for transport.

Do not expose the gear to extreme temperatures (e.g., in a parked car under direct sunlight), as this may cause material damage and shorten its lifespan.

7. Disposal

Packaging materials are raw materials and can be reused. Separate the packaging properly before disposal. You can also obtain more detailed information on this from your responsible administration.

Old devices do not belong in the household waste! Dispose of them properly! Please contact your local administration for information on collection points and opening hours.

- non-observance of the operating instructions,
- improper handling or maintenance, neglect or accidents, as well as
- wear-related damage to the product.
